Directions: You have *five* objectives for each vocabulary word. You must complete letters A, B, C, D, and E for *every* vocabulary word.

A Dictionary define the vocabulary word. Use a dictionary to define the word in your own words (paraphrase) and include the part of speech (Example: noun, verb, adjective, adverb, etc.).

Example: Exulted (V) to be triumphant; rejoice; happy; joy

B Use the vocabulary word correctly in a complete sentence. Underline the vocabulary word in every sentence.

Example: The Shorians exulted in their victory over the Huskies.

C Use the meaning of the vocabulary word correctly, without using the vocabulary word itself, in a complete sentence.

Example: The players jumped up and down singing the fight song after the game.

D Create an illustration or drawing that clearly represents the meaning of the vocabulary word correctly. Stick-Art is great!
